RUBEN SPARTAS MUKASA

Ruben Spartas Mukasa (also known as Bishop Christopher Nilopolian) was a Ugandan church reformer. Seeking a Christian faith that was not tied to colonialism, he founded the Eastern Orthodox Church of Uganda.*

JANANI LUWUM

Janani Luwum was an archbishop in the Church of Uganda. He was one of the most influential leaders of the modern church in Africa. He was martyred for his faith in 1977. **

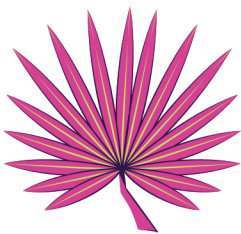

animal.



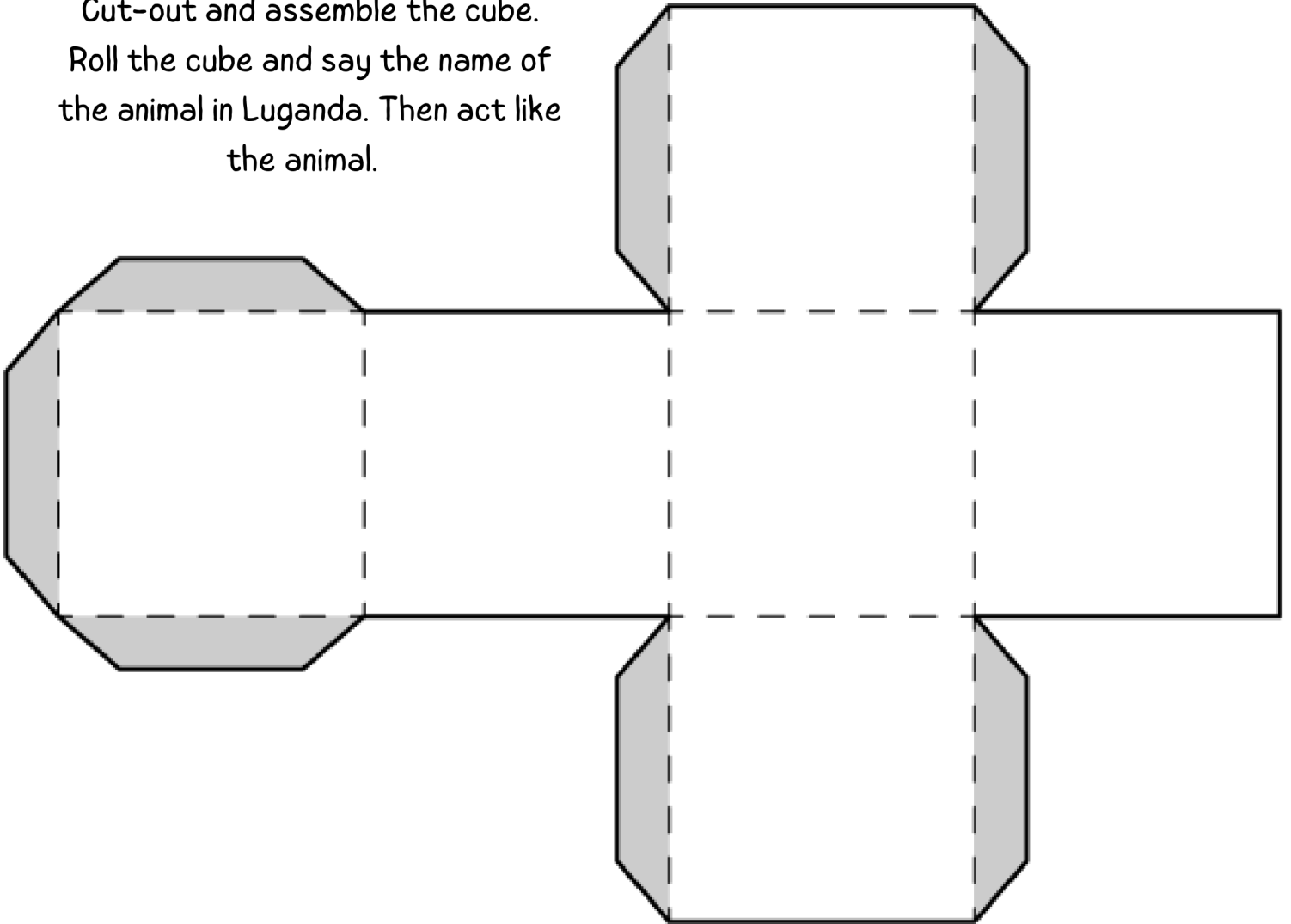

otya' to say 'hello.'


